

## Biography for Dr. Jason Morris



Dr. Jason Morris is a fast-track academic and a two-time winner of the Fulbright award, allowing him to teach and conduct research internationally. During one of his Fulbright grants he spent time advising students at The Hungarian Fulbright Commission's Educational Advising Center in Budapest, Hungary. He currently serves as the Interim Director of Prestigious Scholarships at Abilene Christian University. In addition, Dr. Morris designed and now directs ACU's innovative master's in education program using a distributed learning model to train practitioners for student development positions in higher education settings. Formerly he was Lecturer at Eötvös Loránd University in Budapest, as well as Director of the McNair Scholars Program, a federal program designed to prepare undergraduates for graduate research opportunities, and Academic Coordinator for the Upward Bound Program, a program designed to smooth college entry for underrepresented students. These positions have allowed Dr. Morris to develop significant expertise in helping students find, apply for, and secure financial aid. His areas of academic interest include multicultural and international education and student retention issues. Dr. Morris lives with his family in Abilene, Texas.
